Just program the letters  
ICE  
directly before the name  
of the appropriate person  
in the address  
book of your  
Cell Phone.

The I.C.E. program  
was introduced in  
England last spring and  
really took off there in  
earnest after the July 7  
London Train Bombings.

### **Some Things to Consider:**

The I.C.E. numbers  
in your Cell Phone  
are a supplement to,  
not a substitute for,  
carrying emergency contact  
information in your wallet.

Place ICE before more  
Than one name in your  
cell phone  
-ICE 1- ICE 2- ICE 3-  
etc.- to designate the  
order of your  
emergency contacts.

Be sure the persons  
you've designated  
agree to serve as your  
emergency contact  
and give them pertinent  
Information about any  
medical conditions and a  
list of people you would  
like them to contact on  
your behalf.
